the Association Annual Meeting and was elected a Director, they were looking for younger ideas (some things never change)!

I have since served on the Board of Directors for the San Jose WBA, Dallas WBA, Reno WBA, Nevada State WBA, Greater Dallas USBC and am currently serving as Director for the Denton County USBC. I have served as a delegate to National Conventions for over 40 years representing bowlers from California, Nevada and Texas. At one convention I had the pleasure of being joined by my daughter as an Athlete Delegate and my grandson as a Youth Delegate, making three generations voting together!

In my distant past Vesma Grinfelds and I became the first female Certified Lane Inspectors. I was also a member of the Western Women's Professional Bowlers Tour and won one event at Cloverleaf Family Bowl in Fremont, Ca. I was Woman Bowling Writer of the Year from WIBC; California Golden Nugget; Nevada Silver Strikers and Across Texas Lanes along with several writing awards between 1978 and 2024.

I was the last President of the Reno WBA and the Dallas WBA, and I was the last Vice President of the Nevada State WBA and the Greater Dallas USBC! Bowlers have been buying my homemade jams and jellies for over 20 years, and all the proceeds go to the Veterans.

My highest average was 202 and my highest game was a 300. I was the first woman to roll a perfect game at JB Allen Bowl. I've had numerous 700 series, and I think the highest was 778.
